




Determine desired install location. Mark locations of center to center. (Center to center will be dependent upon the towel bar length. 8", 18", 24" or 30".)


Using a 1/8" bit, predrill a hole in the previously marked location.


(Stud): If mounting to a stud, use the provided wood screw and fasten the mounting tab to the wall. (Ensure the mounting tab is level with the groove facing down.)


(Drywall): If there is no stud to mount to, drill a $\frac{1}{2}$ " hole to push the supplied toggle through. Once the toggle is through the wall, slide the cap down the straps until it is flush with the finish wall. Snap off the excess from the straps.






Place the towel bar onto the mounting tabs.

Using the provided hex key, tighten the set screws down to secure the robe hook to the mounting tab.
